- Come dressed in gym clothes and shoes.



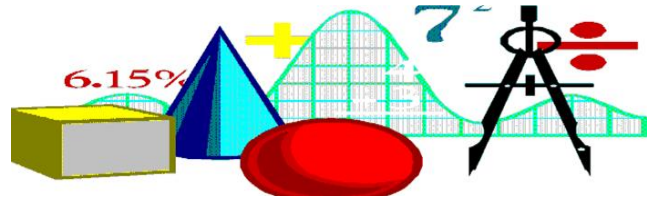
**Halloween Activity Day, Wednesday October 24<sup>th</sup>**

## Do Not Lose Your Bus Privilege

Failure to do so will result in consequences that include:

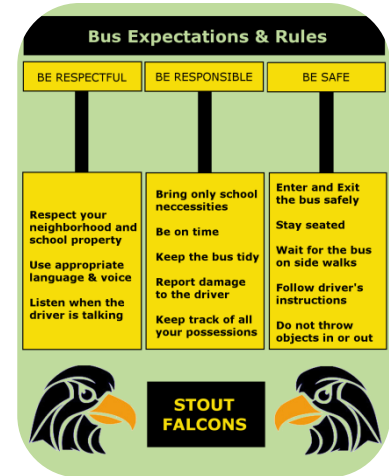
- detentions
