

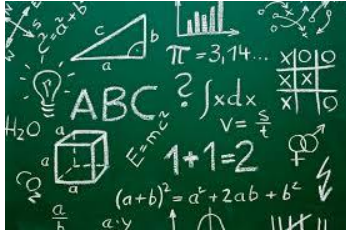

The **1<sup>st</sup> hour class** in each grade that collects the most money for the week wins a **pizza party in January** upon return from winter break.

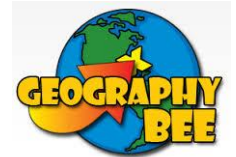
