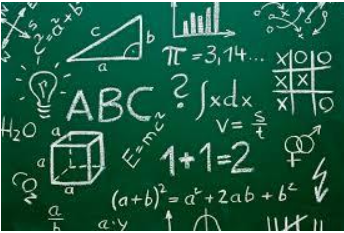

Battle of the Books: Last day to return your 1st Book

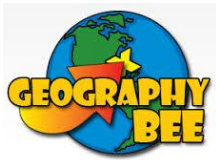
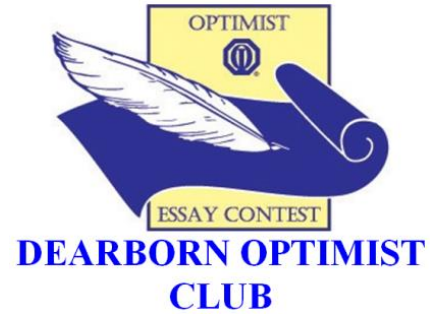
