Thank you all for setting the tone for this performance with our students! The students really stepped up!

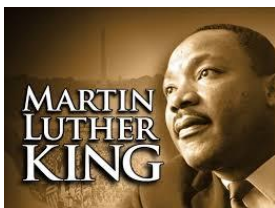
The Detroit Symphony Orchestra staff had a lot of very positive comments about our students, staff, and parents! Our collective efforts really allowed for our students to have a great experience!

There will be a bus to take you home after tryouts. Thank you! **Mrs. Fernandes.**

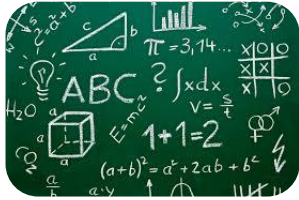
## Girls' basketball Tryouts: Monday, Jan. 28<sup>th</sup>
