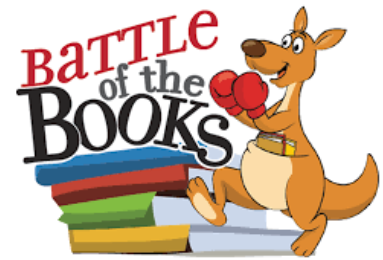
PBIS VIP Experience @ Stout

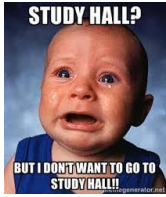
The Battle of Books is coming back to Stout
