I. School Championship: Friday, January 31, 2020

a. Preliminary Round

- ✓ The preliminary round consists of (7) preliminary rounds of 35 questions each.
- ✓ The top ten highest scorers in the school will advance to the next round.
- ✓ *The final 10 are reduced to only 2.*

b. School Championship Round

- ✓ This round is made of three (3) questions.
- ✓ The Champion is declared and receives a medal and a certificate.
- ✓ 2nd and 3rd place contestants receive certificates
- ✓ All participants receive PIZZA.

c. Online Qualifying to State Contest

- ✓ The on-line State Bee qualifying test will be held on Tuesday, February 4, 2020.
- ✓ The school champion has 60 minutes to complete the test in one session.
- ✓ The test consists of 70 multiple-choice questions and includes several visuals (photos, graphs, maps).
- ✓ For students who qualify, the school and the parents/guardians will get email notification.



II. State Contest Round

- ✓ State Bees will be held on Friday, March 27, 2020.
- ✓ Transportation and accommodation expenses in Lansing are the responsibility of student.
- ✓ The state champion receives a medal, cash award, and other prizes.

- ✓ The 2nd and 3rd place students receive cash awards and prizes.
- ✓ All students participating in the state competition will receive T-shirts.

III. National GeoBee Contest

- ✓ State Champions compete for the National title in Washington DC (date to be determined).
- ✓ The National Geography Bee will pay for the transportation and accommodation for the state champion.
- ✓ The Final competition will be televised.

IV. National GeoBee Prizes

- ✓ 1st Prize: **\$25,000 College Scholarship and \$1,000 in Cash.**
A Lifetime subscription in National Geographic Society.
A trip to Galapagos Islands.
- ✓ 2nd Prize: **\$10,000 College Scholarship and \$1,000 in Cash.**
- ✓ 3rd Prize: **\$5,000 College Scholarship and \$1,000 in Cash.**
- ✓ Runner ups: **\$1,000 in Cash for 7 runner-ups.**
